### Ellie Van Winkle Memorial Scholarship

Boulder Amateur Radio Club (BARC) and Boulder Amateur Radio Club Junior (BARC JR) announce that they will award a scholarship of \$2,500 for the year 2018 and will accept applications between the above dates. The formal name of the scholarship is the <u>Ellie Van</u> Winkle Memorial Scholarship. The deadline for receipt of completed applications is June 15, 2018.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- 1. Applicants must be full time, senior year high school students or college and university students who are 25 years of age or younger, as of the closing date of this scholarship announcement (June 15, 2018). High school applicants must be graduating seniors who will be entering college or university in September of the upcoming academic year (September 2018). The definition of full time student will follow the definition of the college or university that he or she is attending. Current college or university students must be planning to continue their studies in the upcoming academic year (September 2018).
- 2. Applicants must be residents of Boulder County, Broomfield County *or* be current members *or* former members of Boulder Amateur Radio Club Junior (BARC Junior). This means that if an applicant is not a resident of Boulder County or Broomfield County, but he or she is a current member or former member of BARC Junior, then he/she is eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- 3. Applicants must be currently licensed radio amateurs.

### **Selection Criteria**

This scholarship will be awarded based on the following selection criteria:

- 1. Academics/Grade Point Average (20 points).
  - What are the main courses you have taken and what is your grade point average?
- 2. Extra curricular activities or service involving school, community, church, or other organization (20 points).

What extra curricular or service activities have you participated in? What contributions of service have you made?

3. Employment experience (20 points).

What employment experiences have you had and what have you learned from these experiences?

4. Amateur radio related activities (20 points).

Please describe your amateur radio related activities. What type of license do you hold and what type of operating have you done? What modes and bands have you utilized? Please mention any radio organizations you are in and the extent of your participation. If you have an amateur radio station in your home at the present time, please describe.

5. Future plans and special circumstances (20 points).

Please describe your future plans and touch on any special circumstances which may apply to your academic plans. Please include a brief mention of how you are generally funding your college or university education.
